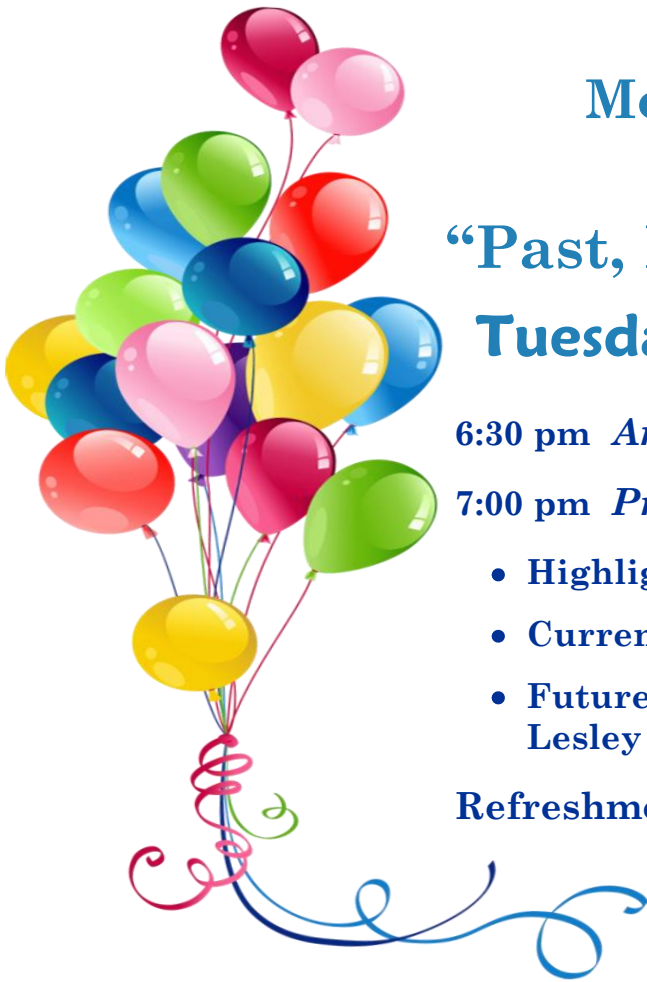

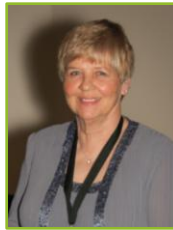
KNOW OUR CANDIDATES
